- starts with a capital letter
- * ends with a 🛛 ?!
- makes complete sense

Capital letters are used:

- ✓ at the beginning of sentences
- ✓ for days of the week and months of the year, e.g. Monday, April
- ✓ for names of things,
 people, places and titles,
 e.g. Jack, Samsung,
 Leicester, Newstead
 Road, Star Wars
- √ for abbreviations, e.g.

 BBC, RSPCA
- full stop shows the end of a statement, e.g. I like swimming.

SENTENCE ENDINGS

question mark shows the end of a question, e.g. Where are you?

punctuation marks can show the end of a sentence.

exclamation mark shows

- * raised voice, e.g. Run!
- * strong feelings, e.g. I
- can't believe you just said that!an exclamation.
- e.g. What a great answer!
