



Modal verbs are a type of verb that tell you about the certainty or possibility of an event.

Examples of possibility

- ✓ We could stay tomorrow.
- ✓ He should be able to help you.
- ✓ Ashanti could dance really well.
- ✓ It may rain.
- ✓ I might help you after school.
- ✓ Alberto can play the guitar.

Least likely

You could stay.
You ought to stay.
You should stay.
You must stay!
You will stay!

Most likely

Modal verbs are:

can might
could shall
will should
would must
may ought to

Examples of certainty

- ✓ We will do maths later.
- ✓ I shall definitely be going on holiday abroad next year.
- ✓ He said he would do
 it tomorrow.



In negative sentences, the modal verb comes before not.

- He might not stay.
- She cannot ride her bike.
- He should not eat any more cake.
- He could not work out where he had gone wrong.
