

PRONOUNS

A **pronoun** can be used instead of a noun or noun phrase.

Pronouns shown on this sheet are personal, **possessive** or reflexive.

Examples:

Amanda waved to Michael.
She waved to him.

John's mother is watching the television.

His mother is watching it.

Singular



I	you	he/she/it
me	you	him/her/it

mine	yours	his/hers/its
------	-------	--------------

myself	yourself	himself/herself/itself
--------	----------	------------------------

Examples:

The old man smiled at his granddaughter.
He patted her on the head.

Lucy was using a phone.
It was hers.

James was feeling pleased with himself.

we	you	they
us	you	them

ours	yours	theirs
------	-------	--------

ourselves	yourselves	themselves
-----------	------------	------------

Examples:

The football team won the trophies easily.
They won them easily.

The dogs belonged to my sister and I. They were ours.

The girls needed to hurry themselves as they were late.
